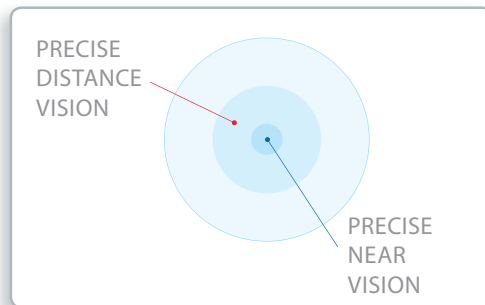

• Do you have astigmatism?

People with presbyopia and astigmatism have very few options for contact lens wear. “Hard”

lenses deliver acceptable vision but are uncomfortable and inconvenient, especially for people with active lifestyles. Soft multifocal torics are more comfortable, but they tend to provide blurry, inconsistent vision, especially at night. *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lenses provide high definition vision all day and into the night, remain stable on the eye to provide consistent clarity, and are comfortable to wear.

• Do you wear “hard” multifocal contact lenses?

If you have a “hard” multifocal contact lens prescription, you may be experiencing less-than-optimal comfort. Rigid lens wearers also have to deal with the irritation of debris collecting under the lens, and rigid lenses move when you blink and may dislodge during activity. With *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lenses, you can enjoy both the comfort and ease-of-wear of a soft lens and the high-definition optics of a rigid lens.



• Are you currently wearing soft multifocal contact lenses?

If you have a soft multifocal contact lens prescription, *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lenses will allow you to upgrade from fuzzy, soft vision to crisp, clear vision. What can I expect?

• Brief adaptation period

It is important to wear your new *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lenses daily for a week or longer to allow your eyes to adapt to the new optical system and experience the lenses in your everyday environment. Your visual clarity will be optimized after you have worn your lenses for a short time and have fully adjusted to the benefits of simultaneous vision. You should also expect a brief period of adaptation to get used to the feel of the hybrid lens. Once you are accustomed to the new design, your *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lenses will provide comfort similar to a soft contact lens.

• Lens handling and care

Inserting, removing, and caring for *SynergEyes* lenses is different than handling and caring for soft or “hard” lenses. Your eye care professional will provide you with instructions on how to properly handle and care for your *SynergEyes* lenses.



• Replacement schedule

The recommended replacement schedule for the *SynergEyes® Multifocal* lens is every six months.
